1 General

1.1 Name of Work:

Madhya Pradesh Metro Rail Corporation Limited (“MPMRCL” - “the Employer”) invites online open e-tenders from eligible applicants, who fulfil the qualification criteria stipulated in Clause 1.3 of NIT, for the Tender Package BH&IN-04: “Procurement and Construction of Chain Link Fabric Fencing with MS Fabricated Gate, within Municipal boundaries of Bhopal and Indore for Bhopal Metro Rail Project and for Indore Metro Rail Project”.

1.3 QUALIFICATION CRITERIA

1.3.1 Eligible Applicants

- 1.3.1.1 Tenders for this Contract will only be considered from those Tenderers (proprietorship firms, partnership firms, companies, corporations) who meet the eligibility criteria prescribed in this NIT. Tenders are open to Indian firms only.
- 1.3.1.2 A Tenderer shall only submit one Tender in the same tendering process. A tenderer who submits or participates in more than one Tender will cause all of the proposals in which the tenderer has participated to be disqualified. No tenderer can be a subcontractor while submitting a Tender individually in the same tendering process.
- 1.3.1.3 Tenderers shall not have a conflict of interest. All tenderers found to have a conflict of interest shall be disqualified. Tenderers shall be considered to have a conflict of interest with one or more parties in this tendering process, if:
- A tenderer has been engaged by the Employer to provide consulting services for the preparation related to the procurement of or on the implementation of the project;
 - A tenderer has any associates/ affiliates (inclusive of parent firms) mentioned in subparagraph (a) above; or
 - A tenderer lends, or temporarily seconds its personnel to firms or organisations which are engaged in consulting services for the preparation related to the procurement of or on the implementation of the project, if the

personnel would be involved in any capacity on the same project.

- 1.3.1.4 A firm, who has paid tender fee for the tender document in their name, can only submit the tender.
- 1.3.1.5 Any Central or State Government Organisation/ department/ Public Sector Undertaking/ other Government entity including Delhi Metro Rail Corporation and/or other Metro Rail Corporations/ Multilateral/ Bilateral funding agencies must not have blacklisted or debarred the tenderer as on the due date of online tender submission. The tenderer should submit an undertaking to this effect in Appendix – 10 of Letter of Tender given in the tender document.
- 1.3.1.6 The Tenderer for the works awarded during last ten years ending on the Credential Cut-Off Date (as confirmed in NIT para 1.3.2.1 below);
 - a. must not have been imposed maximum liquidated damages of 10% of the contract value in a contract or penalty of 10% (or more) of the contract value.
 - b. The tenderer should submit an undertaking to this effect in Appendix – 11 of Letter of Tender.
- 1.3.1.7 If there is any misrepresentation of the facts with regards to the undertaking(s), forms, statements and/or any other details submitted, the same will be considered as “Fraudulent practice” and such tenders will be summarily rejected.
- 1.3.1.8 The Tenderer must not have suffered bankruptcy or insolvency during the previous 60 months from the last date of online tender submission. The Tenderer should submit an undertaking to this effect in Appendix – 12 of Letter of Tender.
- 1.3.1.9 Tenderers shall not have applied for/ obtained corporate debt restructuring in immediately preceding 36 months from the last date of online tender submission. However, the Tenderer, who have applied for/ obtained corporate debt restructuring, shall also be considered eligible, only in case the Tenderer’s account(s) is/are classified as “standard account” as on the Credential Cut-Off Date (as confirmed in NIT para 1.3.2.1 below).

The tenderer shall submit an appropriate undertaking in the format given in Appendix – 14 of LOT, along with the appropriate certificate from the statutory auditor (for not applied for/ obtained corporate debt restructuring) or from the statutory auditor and the banker(s) (for account(s) is/are classified as “standard account”).

- 1.3.1.10 Consortium/ Joint Ventures are not eligible to participate for this Tender.
- 1.3.1.11 Tenderers, who are qualifying as “Class-I Local Supplier” in terms of sub-clauses 6.5.5.1 and 6.5.5.2 of Instructions to Tenders (ITT), shall only be eligible to participate in this tendering process.

1.3.2 **Minimum Eligibility Criteria**

- 1.3.2.1 The Tenderer shall submit details of works previously executed by them to be considered qualified for the minimum eligibility criteria.

Documentary proof should be submitted, namely; client completion certificates

clearly indicating the nature and scope of work, actual completion costs, actual completion dates. Tenders submitted without this documentary proof shall not be evaluated.

In case the work is executed for a private client the following shall be submitted: copy of the work order(s), bill of quantities, details of payments received, T.D.S. certificates for all payments received and copy of the final/last bill paid.

Credential Cut-Off Date: 30th June 2021

The value of successfully executed sections of any ongoing work up to the Credential Cut-Off Date will be considered for qualification of work experience criteria.

For executed works, the value of work done shall be updated to the Credential Cut-Off Date price level assuming 5% inflation for Indian Rupees per year (or part thereof).

1.3.2.2 **Work Experience**

The tenderers will be qualified only if they satisfy the minimum eligibility criteria as given below within the past 7 (seven) years ending on the Credential Cut-Off Date (as confirmed in NIT para 1.3.2.1 above):

- a. At least one “**Similar Works**” ** of value of **INR 48,86,000/-** (excluding all taxes, duties, levies, cess and GST) or more.
or
- b. Two “**Similar Works**” ** each of value of **INR 30,54,000/-** (excluding all taxes, duties, levies, cess and GST) or more.
or
- c. Three “**Similar Works**” ** each of value of **INR 24,43,000/-** (excluding all taxes, duties, levies, cess and GST) or more.

** “**Similar Work**” for this contract shall be the substantial completion (at least 80% of value) of any Construction/ Repair/ Renovation of Civil Structures for any Indian Central/ State Government Department, Central/State Autonomous Body or Central/State Public Sector Undertaking.

1.3.2.3 **Financial Standing**

- 1.3.2.3.1 Financial data for last five audited financial years has to be submitted by the Tenderer in Appendix – 9 of LOT along with audited financial statements.

The financial data in the prescribed format shall be endorsed / signed in original and stamped by a Chartered Accountant along with the CA’s membership number.

- 1.3.2.3.2 The Tenderers will be qualified only if they have minimum financial capabilities as below:

The average annual turnover from civil works of last five financial years should be **≥ INR 91,61,000/-**.
- 1.3.3 Tender submissions shall be considered for further evaluation, only if the Minimum Eligibility (Sub-Clause 1.3.2) Criteria are met; otherwise the tender shall be summarily rejected.

- 1.7** All tenderers are hereby cautioned that tenders containing any material deviation or reservations as described in the “Instructions to Tenderers” shall be considered as non-responsive and is liable to be rejected.
- 1.8 The tenderers shall note the following:**
- i. Notice Inviting Tenders along with tender documents is published in the e-procurement portal; <https://etenders.gov.in/eprocure/app> . Tendering processes like download, tender queries, corrigenda, submissions, openings, evaluations, etc. can be done through the e-procurement portal only. All the tenderers willing to participate must be enrolled/ registered on the e-

procurement portal.

- ii. Those who are not already registered, can enrol themselves using the link “Online Bidder Enrollment” on e-procurement portal.
- iii. Possession of a valid Class III Digital Signature Certificate (DSC) is a prerequisite for registration and participating in the tender submission activities through this e-procurement portal. Digital Signature Certificate (DSC) must be obtained from any Certifying Authority empanelled with the Controller of Certifying Authority of India, details of which are available on e-procurement portal under the link “Information about DSC”. - 1.18 The Employer reserves the right to accept or reject any or all Tenders The Employer is not bound to accept the lowest or any tender and may at any time by publishing a notice in writing terminate the tendering process. No claim in this regard will be admissible.
- 1.19 The Contract will be awarded to the preferred Tenderer whose Tender has been determined to be substantially responsive and compliant to the requirements contained in the Tender Documents and who has offered the Lowest Evaluated Price as per Clause 7 of Instruction to Tenderers, subject to the quoted amount is considered to be acceptable.
- 1.20 Any suit or application, arising out of any dispute or differences on account of this Tender shall be filed in a competent court at Bhopal, Madhya Pradesh only and no other court or any other district of the country shall have any jurisdiction in the matter.
